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




DELO role – two different "NSPA" tasks.

EKSEMPLER PÅ 'AFSLAG'

- NSPA is only working with firms possessing well-established structures, firm financially sounds and with solid past performance in the same/similar area.
- Suppliers desiring to be registered in the NSPA Source File have to present documentary evidence that they have sold or currently sell the same or similar materiel or services to the Armed Forces of their own, in addition:
- - Possession of a "quality system" (ISO or AQAP) recognized as satisfactory by their own military or civilian governmental Authorities. Evidence of this quality system should be provided at the time of a Source File registration application.
- - Possession of appropriate capability, technological know-how and/or licenses, to be demonstrated by the applicant.





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REGISTRATION IN THE NSPA SOURCE FILE

Supplier Eligibility is based upon:

- 1. Legal personality
- 2. Nationality
 - a) Country of incorporation or legal residence; and
 - b) Main production facilities and/or effective administration, in a NSPO nation"
 - i. Non-NATO nations associated member to NSPO Support Partnerships

3. Present capability

a) Consistent with incorporation documentation

Defense Systems or critical:

- a) OEM
- b) Past performance
- c) Technical knowledge, licenses, certifications,...
- 4. Financial standing

NSPA provides advance information about potential business opportunities through its Future Business Opportunities (FBO) or Notification of Intent (NoI) publications. Once a customer requirement is ready to be solicited, the Agency will publish all the information as Requests For Proposals (RFP) to allow qualified firms to bid.


An xml data file containing the FBOs, NoIs and public RFPs currently published is available here. The technical documentation of this file is also available in English and in French.

Future Business Opportunities (FBO)

NSPA publishes at the earliest opportunity potential or future requirements with an estimated value of Financial Level D (160.000 EUR) or above as Future Business Opportunities (FBOs).

AFSC

The AFSC portal is an on-line business content management portal designed to support the Alliance Future Surveillance and Control (AFSC) community. Providing a secure means of sharing information within the AFSC community, the portal hosts a schedule of events and meetings, an electronic library, configuration control processes and technical documentation workspaces.

AGS

The NATO AGS Life-Cycle Support Business Portal (LSBP) is the on-line business content management portal supporting official events and meetings, electronic Materiel Support Services, configuration control processes and technical documentation workspaces all designed to provide a secure means to share information within the AGS community.

ALPS

The A400M Logistics Portal System (ALPS) is the logistics portal for electronic Materiel Support Services for the A400M aircraft. The ALPS provides on-line access and automated functionalities to users from Participating States, OCCAR A400M PD and Industries to access technical & commercial information, perform ordering activities and manage order life cycle from order placement up to invoicing using internet/web technology.

eCIS

eCIS is a web application that provides a secure access to information related to SAP ERP business transactions occurring between NSPA and its partners.

eProcurement

The NSPA ePortal contains a new eProcurement module which in addition to an improved eBid application also hosts Future Business Opportunities – advanced notification of future large procurement opportunities and the ability to view and bid upon both Notices of Intent (NOIs) and Requests For Proposals (RFPs) for Infrastructure Projects.

N@MSIS

The NATO @lectronic Materiel Support Information System (N@MSIS) is the on-line business portal for electronic Materiel Support Services currently supporting the two helicopter weapon systems NH90 and TIGER. It automates to the maximum extent possible the logistics processes agreed upon with the NSPA partners for the spare parts provisioning cycle from price information to electronic invoicing and payment.

NACC

The NATO Air Command and Control (NACC) Web Portal is a web based application providing a community based content management system, including document workspaces and electronic voting processes. It offers functions for voting on Configuration management documents (ECPs, SOURs, Surplus Cases) and acquiring document approval through the eSilence process.

NAP

The NSPA Automation Portal (NAP) is the logistics portal for electronic Materiel Support Services based on the AeroSpace and Defence Industries Association of Europe Specification 2000M (ASD S2000M). The NAP provides on-line access and automated functionalities to users from Participating States, Agencies and Industries to access technical & commercial information, perform ordering activities and manage order life cycle from order placement up to invoicing using internet/web technology.

NATO GPSS

The General Procurement Shared Services provides a capability to enhance the way NATO currently acquires goods and services by developing consolidated "Strategic Sourcing Contracts" for selected General Procurement commodities, goods and services. By doing so, NATO will maximize its purchasing power to ensure its various organizational elements can obtain their requirements at the best value, This approach addresses all levels of the purchasing process to realize savings.


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


