



SALES IN DENMARK*



Industrial Return Ratio 2024-2025






SALES IN DENMARK*











DELO role – two different "NSPA" tasks.

EKSEMPLER PÅ 'AFSLAG'

- NSPA is only working with firms possessing well-established structures, firm financially sounds and with solid past performance in the same/similar area.
- Suppliers desiring to be registered in the NSPA Source File have to present documentary evidence that they have sold or currently sell the same or similar material or services to the Armed Forces of their own, in addition:
- - Possession of a "quality system" (ISO or AQAP) recognized as satisfactory by their own military or civilian governmental Authorities. Evidence of this quality system should be provided at the time of a Source File registration application.
- Possession of appropriate capability, technological know-how and/or licenses, to be demonstrated by the applicant.
